SPSS Independent Samples T Test

SPSS independent samples t-test is a procedure for testing whether the means in two populations on one metric variable are equal

Example

- A marketer wants to know whether women spend the same amount of money on clothes as men.
- She asks 30 male and 30 female respondents how many Euros they spend on clothing each month.

The null hypothesis

Men and women spend the same amount of money each month on clothing's
